

While you are staying in Edmonton, it is vital that you learn the ETS Bus routes. This will help you in getting to know your surroundings as well as the timings of the buses and trains.




While using the Transit System, there will be a fare of \$3.50 one way. There are other efficient ways to pay for travelling without buying tickets every day:

- Buying a set of 10 tickets costing at roughly \$27.50 every 2 weeks
- Monthly pass for the entire month costing at \$100 per month
- Investing in an ARC card. This is a new initiative started by the Edmonton Transit System. With this, you can add funds and tap it at the designated station every time you travel.
